**In Dane County, there are nearly 300 foster children and over 400 children in kinship care.** A kinship family is when a relative, such as Grandma, is the primary caregiver. Foster and kinship families are an often-forgotten population frequently operating on the financial margins while caring for children who may have arrived with just the clothes on their backs. They are big on love and often short on money.
